

ONLINE BENEFICIARY DESIGNATION IS AVAILABLE

California Resources Corporation (CRC) has partnered with Prudential to maintain beneficiary records for the CRC life insurance plans. It is critical that Prudential has up-to-date beneficiary records for you to ensure that your life insurance benefits are paid to the beneficiary(ies) of your choice.

You must submit a beneficiary designation for the CRC Basic Life Insurance Plan (Company-paid). Your designated beneficiary will be the same for your CRC Occupational Accidental Death and Dismemberment Plan (Company-paid) and Accidental Death and Dismemberment Plan (if enrolled).

To make it as easy as possible for you to designate your beneficiary(ies), we are pleased to offer two convenient beneficiary designation methods – via a secure Internet site, or by mail.

To designate your beneficiary through the Internet:

1. Access the Beneficiary Designation website at www.prudential.com/mybenefits
2. Select “Register Here”
3. In the Control Number field, enter **#51849**
4. Complete the required information on the following screens and create a personal User ID and personal password

To designate your beneficiary through the Mail:

1. Obtain a paper beneficiary designation form by contacting the Customer Service Office or
2. Access the Beneficiary Designation website at www.prudential.com/mybenefits
 - Select “Register Here”
 - In the Control Number field, enter **#51849**
 - Complete the required information on the following screens and create a personal User ID and personal password
 - Download and print a beneficiary form
 - Return the completed beneficiary designation form to the address provided on the form.

Note: You can view and update your beneficiary designation online at any time by accessing www.prudential.com/mybenefits, even if the designation was made through the mail. You will need to register in order to access your account.

Important! If you fail to designate your beneficiaries, at time of a life claim, your benefits will be paid based on a “preferential beneficiary designation” clause. This means that any amount of

insurance for which there is no beneficiary at your death will be payable to the first of the following:

- (a) Your surviving spouse
- (b) Your surviving child(ren) in equal shares or if none;
- (c) Your surviving parents, in equal shares or if none;
- (d) Your surviving siblings, in equal shares or if none;
- (e) Your estate
